

GENERAL ELECTION - NOVEMBER 8, 2016

Proposed Charter Amendments City of Delaware

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

The proposed charter amendments make revisions to Sections 4A, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 21, 26, 45, 46, 47, 50, 66, 67, 70, 71, 74, 75, 76, 77, 83, 84, 85, 86, 89, 90, 92, 95, 101, 102, 104, 107, 109, 110, 113, 114, 118, 119, and 126. Changes include allowing City Council to approve intergovernmental agreements by Resolution, adding a requirement that notice of a vacancy on City Council be provided to the public to provide an opportunity for citizens to apply, and shifting from requiring paper to permitting electronic records and notification throughout the Charter. The proposal also establishes clearer criteria under which City Council members may be disciplined and/or expelled and provides a process for doing so.
