## PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT) GENOA TOWNSHIP

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Genoa Township for the purpose of PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATIONS OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT POLICE PERSONNEL, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE POLICEMEN EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.33 OF THE REVISED CODE, OR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS INCURRED BY TOWNSHIPS AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTS MADE WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE POLICE PROTECTION, OR TO PROVIDE AMBULANCE OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A POLICE DEPARTMENT at a rate not exceeding 4.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.44 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years commencing in 2000, first due in calendar year 2001.
