

SPECIAL ELECTION – MAY 3, 2005

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT AND DECREASE) GENOA TOWNSHIP

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.

A replacement of two existing levies, being a reduction of 1.2 mills to constitute a tax for the benefit of Genoa Township for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, BUILDINGS, OR SITES THEREFOR, OR SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY AND MATERIALS, OR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF LINES OF FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH, OR THE PAYMENT OF PERMANENT, PART-TIME, OR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANIES TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE FIREFIGHTER EMPLOYERS' CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, OR THE PURCHASE OF AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT, OR TO PROVIDE AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC, OR OTHER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANY** at a rate not exceeding 3.3 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.33 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2005, first due in calendar year 2006.
