

SPECIAL ELECTION – MAY 3, 2005

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT AND DECREASE) GENOA TOWNSHIP

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.

A replacement of a portion of an existing levy, being a reduction of 1.1 mills, to constitute a tax for the benefit of Genoa Township for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT POLICE PERSONNEL, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE POLICE EMPLOYERS' CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.33 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, OR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS INCURRED BY TOWNSHIPS AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTS MADE WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN POLICE PROTECTION** at a rate not exceeding 3.3 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.33 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2005, first due in calendar year 2006.
