

PRIMARY ELECTION – MAY 4, 2010

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT AND INCREASE) GENOA TOWNSHIP

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A replacement of 3.3 mills of an existing levy and an increase of 0.5 mill to constitute tax for the benefit of Genoa Township for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATIONS OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT POLICE PERSONNEL, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE POLICE EMPLOYERS' CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.33 OF THE REVISED CODE, OR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS INCURRED BY TOWNSHIPS AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTS MADE WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN POLICE PROTECTION** at a rate not exceeding 3.8 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.38 for each one hundred dollars in valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
