

## **GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 4, 2003**

### **PROPOSED BOND ISSUE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP AND CITY OF POWELL**

**A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.**

Shall bonds be issued by Liberty Township for the purpose of **PROVIDING COMMUNITY RECREATION FACILITIES, INCLUDING DEVELOPMENT OF A FIFTY ACRE PARK INCLUDING SUCH AREAS AS MULTI-PURPOSE PLAYING FIELDS, PAVED TRAIL, SHELTERS AND A COMMUNITY GREEN; EXPANSION OF THE EXISTING RECREATION CENTER FOR ADDITIONAL PROGRAM AND GYMNASIUM SPACE; AND CONSTRUCTION OF A FAMILY-ORIENTED OUTDOOR AQUATIC FACILITY; FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING THE SAME; IMPROVING SITES THEREOF, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL PARKING AND IMPROVED ACCESS**, in the principal amount of \$9,230,000 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 27 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 0.7 mill for each one dollar of tax valuation which amounts to \$0.07 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2003, first due in calendar year 2004, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?
