

GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 6, 2012

Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement and Increase) Liberty Township

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.

A replacement of 6 mills of an existing levy and an increase of .6 mill to constitute a tax for the benefit of Liberty Township for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, and the payment of permanent, part-time firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employer's contribution required under section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, at a rate not exceeding 6.6 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.66 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2012, first due in calendar year 2013.
