

GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 7, 2000

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT AND INCREASE) ORANGE TOWNSHIP

A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.

A replacement of 4 mills of an existing levy and an increase of 2.85 mills, to constitute a tax for the benefit of Orange Township for the purpose of PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, BUILDINGS OR SITES THEREFOR, OR SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY AND MATERIALS THEREFOR, OR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF LINES OF FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH, OR THE PAYMENT OF PERMANENT, PART-TIME OR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OR FIRE-FIGHTING COMPANIES TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF FIREMEN EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.34 OF THE REVISED CODE, OR TO PURCHASE AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT, OR TO PROVIDE AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC, OR OTHER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR FIRE-FIGHTING COMPANY; at a rate not exceeding 6.85 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.685 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 3 years commencing in 2000, first due in calendar year 2001.
